- 1) An entrance application form, an exam admission ticket, a duplicate deposit ticket, a return envelop for sending you the result, and a health certificate: state in the designate form on guidelines for applicants
- 2) A copy of test certificate of 2nd grade or above in the Japanese proficiency test
- 3) Resume: state your academic and working careers and purpose of study abroad (in Japanese or English, no specific format)
- 4) Diploma and transcript: they should be collected from the last school you attended and written in Japanese or English (Any copy is not accepted).
- 5) Identification Card: A signed paper to certify that a referee (an financially independent person aged 25 years and above who currently lives in Japan under Japanese citizenship) guarantees all financial matters and lifestyle guidance of the candidate (Referee's certificate of residence should be attached, no specific format)
